

DEVELOPING A PD MINISTRY



STEP 1FOUNDATION

- Watch the <u>Conquer Series</u> as a church leadership team (staff and ministry leaders).
- Ontact our International Group Coordinators at groups@puredesire.org to become familiar with Pure Desire groups and best practices.
 - Discuss <u>hosting a PD Conference</u> or <u>find an upcoming one</u> in your area to send your leaders to.
 - · Consider caring for your leaders through PD Leaders.
 - Get connected with the men's and women's <u>Regional Group Leaders</u> (RGLs) in your area who will be available to coach you.
- Create a leadership team of men (four to six) and women (four to six) to develop and train as your first PD group leaders.



STEP 2ADDICTION GROUPS

- Description Launch your groups using any of the following methods:
 - · Present a three-to-five-week sermon series on sexual purity.
 - · Invite people to share their testimony of healing and restoration.
 - · Use the Conquer Series trailer and Conquer Series promotional kit.
- Eaunch Conquer Series groups with an anonymous way to sign up.
- After completing the *Conquer Series*, give men the option of joining a <u>Seven Pillars of Freedom</u> group.
- Introduce <u>Unraveled</u> groups for addicted women.



STEP 3

PD CONFERENCE

- Work with the Pure Desire event team at events@puredesire.org to host or send your leaders to a <u>PD Conference</u> (PD-C).
- Collaborate with other churches in your area to promote the PD-C.



STEP 4

BETRAYAL GROUPS

- Start <u>Betrayal & Beyond</u> groups for women who are struggling with betrayal issues relating to sex addiction.
- Begin <u>Hope for Men</u> groups for men who are struggling with issues relating to their spouse's love and/or sexual addiction.



STEP 5

YOUNG ADULT GROUPS

- Present <u>Living Free</u> groups for college-aged men.
- Organize <u>Top Gun</u> groups for high school guys.
- Begin <u>Behind the Mask</u> groups for high school girls.

Though we recommend this order of implementation, the process does not look the same in every church.
